Northern Neck Master Gardeners
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Reduction of sediment pollution from residential properties is one of the major challenges facing the restoration of Chesapeake Bay. The Shoreline Evaluation Program (SEP) was established to help address this challenge. The program is designed to help waterfront homeowners improve the protection of their property in ways that also reduce sediment runoff into their nearshore waters. Using know-how from the Virginia Institute for Marine Science and the Virginia Cooperative Extension, SEP volunteers provide an on-site evaluation of property protection from both seawater and stormwater. Following the site visit, SEP prepares an emailed, written report with specific integrated shoreline protection recommendations. Included with the report is a password for online access to the *SEP Homeowners Guide to Shoreline Management* that contains extensive shoreline protection and landscape information.

To request an evaluation, please complete this form and the questionnaire and mail both to the address below, together with a check for **\$75 made payable to NNMG**. The fee covers the costs of the evaluation site visit and materials. Any excess is used in the SEP educational and communications programs.
