

Suggested Low Growing Riparian Buffer Plants for Virginia Northern Neck

Partly Shady Lower Bank (3-6 Hours of Sun), Occasional Brackish Water Inundation

Plant requirements: deer resistant, drought tolerant once established, <4' to maintain views, salt tolerant, wet soil tolerant.


