

Suggested Low Growing Riparian Buffer Plants for Virginia Northern Neck

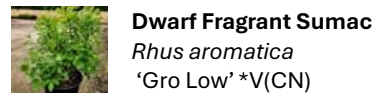
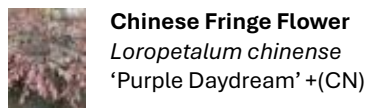
Sunny Upper Bank (>6 Hours of Sun), No Inundation

Plant requirements: deer resistant, drought tolerant once established, <4' to maintain views.

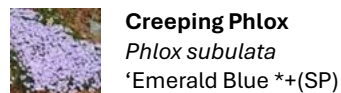
Retaining recommended for slopes >30%.



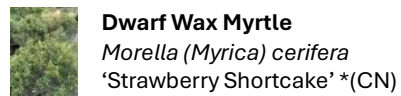
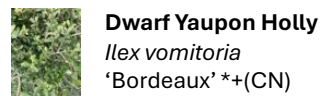
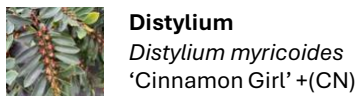
